SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 41(b-2) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "General Provisions on Issue of Licenses," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

(b-2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, in Baltimore City the holder of <code>[a]</code> one or more "Class B" (on sale—hotels and restaurants) beer, wine and liquor <code>[license]</code> licenses under this article, by making application in the regular manner and paying the usual fee, may obtain <code>[an]</code> additional "Class B" (on sale—hotels and restaurants) beer, wine and liquor <code>[license]</code> licenses for premises operated as a public hotel and having <code>[seventy-five]</code> one hundred or more rooms, <code>[half]</code> of which are for transient trade, <code>]</code> or as an apartment house and public hotel having one hundred fifty or more apartments PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT NO SUCH LICENSEE MAY OBTAIN OR HOLD AT ANY ONE TIME MORE

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

THAN THREE CLASS B (ON SALE—HOTELS AND RESTAU-

RANTS) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSES.

CHAPTER 343 (House Bill 1006)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 90 (b) (2) and 95B of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", subtitle "Hours and Days for Sale", to permit Class C "on sale" (clubs) beer, beer and light wine, or beer, wine and liquor licensees in Cecil County to sell PERMIT THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF alcoholic beverages between certain hours on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 90 (b) (2) and 95B of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", subtitle "Hours and Days for Sale", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
