CHAPTER 429

(House Bill 977)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 36(6) of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Workmen's Compensation," subtitle "Claims and Compensation; Benefits," to change the rate of compensation for temporary partial disability.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 36(6) of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume), title "Workmen's Compensation," subtitle "Claims and Compensation; Benefits," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

36.

(6) Temporary Partial Disability. In case of temporary partial disability, an injured employee shall receive fifty per centum of the difference between his average weekly wages and his wage-earning capacity thereafter in the same employment or otherwise if less than before the accident, but not to exceed [twenty-five] *forty* dollars per week, during the continuance of such partial disability, but not in excess of four thousand dollars, except as otherwise provided in this article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

CHAPTER 430

(House Bill 981)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 37(d) of Article 101 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume and 1967 Supplement), title "Workmen's Compensation," subtitle "Claims and Compensation; Benefits," to change the amount of payment of funeral benefits where death results from a compensable injury.
