Ordered, That his Excellency the Governor be requested to communicate to this House all the facts and circumstances in his possession relative to the contract between the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company and the Barings, Brothers and Company, on the subject of the State's bonds, referred to in his message to this legislature, and such other matter as his excellency may choose to communicate to this House of Delegates.
