

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act for the relief of the German Reformed and Lutheran Congregation of Salem Church in Boonsboro', Washington county, passed December session 1834, chapter 16;

Severally endorsed "will pass" and ordered to be engrossed.

Also, returned the bill entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to the public roads in the several counties therein mentioned, passed December session 1801, chapter 54, so far as the same relates to Charles county;

Endorsed "will pass," with the proposed amendments:

Amendments proposed.

Strike out "slave labor" in the 3d and 4th line and insert "the labor of slaves and free persons of color;"

Read the first and by special order the second time and assented to, and the bill as amended ordered to be engrossed.

And the bill entitled, an act for the relief of the representatives of Susan Pryor;

Endorsed "will not pass."

And delivered a bill entitled, an act relating to the trustees of school district No. 4, called Mountain district in Frederick county;

Endorsed "will pass."

Read and referred to Messrs. Biser, Firor and Simmons.

The house resumed the consideration of the bill from the senate entitled, an act to give to the chancellor and the county courts as courts of equity jurisdiction in cases of divorce.

The question being on the motion of Mr. Risteau to strike out the enacting clause.

Mr. Holmes moved the previous question and being demanded by a majority of the members present, the main question was then put: Will the house agree to strike out the enacting clause?
