The house took up for consideration the bill, entitled, an act to regulate the municipal government of Howard District of Anne Arundel county;

Mr. Ridgely moved to amend said bill by striking out the first section and inserting the following:

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the purpose of exercising all the powers, and performing the duties within Howard District, now required of the commissioners of Anne Arundel county, there shall be three persons elected, the said election shall take place on the first Saturday in April next,
