

The house resumed the consideration of the bill, entitled, an act to authorise the construction of a bridge and causeway across the Patuxent river at Queen Anne;

The question being on the motion of Mr. Owens to amend the amendments from the committee by striking out the words "and causeway" and inserting the word "and" between the word "bridge abutments," and striking out "three thousand dollars" and inserting "fifteen hundred dollars;"

And on the same being put,

It was determined in the affirmative.

The question then recurred on assenting to the said amendments from the committee as amended;

And on being put,

It was determined in the affirmative.

The question then recurred on the passage of the said bill;

And on being put,

It was passed with the said amendments.

The house took up for consideration the bill, entitled, an act for the incorporation of the Mechanics Circulating Library Society of Cumberland, Maryland;

Read the second time and will pass.

Also, the bill, entitled, an act to define certain powers of the courts of Chancery in this State;

The question being on assenting to the amendments from the committee on grievances and courts of justice to whom the said bill was referred;

And on the same being put, they were assented to.

The bill as amended was read the second time and will pass.

The house then took up for consideration the bill, entitled, an act supplemental to an act, providing for the appointment of lime inspectors for the city of Baltimore and prescribing their duties, passed December session, 1832;

On motion of Mr. Risteau,

The first section was amended by striking out the words "and charcoal" in the third line, and by inserting the word "in" after the word "made" in the fourth line.

On motion of Mr. Risteau,

The words "and charcoal," in the third line of second section were stricken out, and the word "convenience" inserted after the word "public" in the same line.

On motion of Mr. Risteau,

All after the word "barrels," in the fourth line down to the word "hogsheads," in the fifth line of the fourth section was stricken out.

Mr. Risteau moved further to amend said section, by adding thereto the following:

"Provided, however, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to compel the manufacturer of lime to have such lime
