Cesna for seven dollars thirty-seven cents, Henry McNulty for eight dollars, N. P. Ryan for fifty-eight dollars, Daniel Shawan for twenty-five dollars sixty-two cents, Sinseny & Barnes for four dollars fifty cents, Philip Fletcher for fifteen dollars fifty cents, J. D. Kerney for seven dollars, L. M. Jameson for fifteen dollars sixty-two cents, Hough and Taylor six dollars twenty-five cents, L. P.
