Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorised and directed to appoint some fit and proper person to value the damages done by the aforementioned survey of the Eastern Shore Rail Road to the property of Robert Malone, of Somerset county, and to report the same on oath to the Governor, who is hereby authorised and required to pay that amount to said Robert Malone or his order;
