Said bill was amended by striking out the word "submit" in the 6th line of the 1st section, and inserting the word "deliver."

Also, the word "submitted" in the 2nd line of 2nd section was stricken out and the word "delivered" inserted.

And also the word "submit" in the 6th line of said section was stricken out and the word "deliver" inserted.

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

The word "fifty" in the 4th line of the 2nd section was stricken out and the words "five hundred" inserted.

Mr. Tuck moved further to amend said section by adding thereto the following;

"To be recovered by civil process and paid out of the private funds of the president of any company who may offend against the provisions of this act:" Which was read.

Mr. Mason moved to amend the amendment by adding thereto the following "and upon conviction of the offence the said president shall be sentenced to the penitentiary for a term not less than two years, nor more than five."

On the question being put: Will the house agree to amend the amendment?

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred on agreeing to the amendment offered by Mr. Tuck, and on being put—

It was determined in the affirmative.

Mr. England moved to lay the said bill and amendments on the table;

On the question being put—
