So the house sustained the opinion of the chair.

The question before the house was on assenting to the amendment from the senate to the resolution relating to the Eastern Shore Rail Road, to strike out all of the resolution after the word "revoked;"

And on the same being put,

It was assented to and ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Spence then asked and obtained leave to withdraw the resolutions submitted by him on the 28th February last, which left before the house as the only proposition the bill reported by Mr. Owens, entitled, an act relating to the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company.

Mr. Martin then moved as a substitute for said bill the following:

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That on condition that the president and directors of the Eastern Shore Rail Road Company will suspend the further prosecution of their work until the end of the next session of the General Assembly, and discharge all their officers and agents, or discontinue their salaries during the suspension, except such officer or officers as may be necessary on the most economical scale, to keep and protect the books, papers and other property of the said company, and upon the same being certified to the Treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland by the said president and directors to the said treasurer shall issue or cause to be issued by the commissioner of loans, and pay to the said president and directors, certificates of debt or currency bonds of this State, bearing six per cent. interest, and redeemable in thirty years after the date thereof, sixty-five thousand dollars, if necessary for the purpose of paying the debts of the said company now due, which sum shall be considered as paid on the subscription of the said State to the capital stock of the said company.
