

The bill, entitled, an act to divorce James Hays, of the city of Baltimore from his wife Mary Ann Hays ;

The bill, entitled, an act to divorce Susan Brice, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband John P. Brice ;

The bill entitled, an act to authorise a lottery to raise a sum of money to construct a turnpike road from Hagerstown, Washington county, through Leitersburg to the Pennsylvania state line, and for introducing wholesome water into the town of Leitersburg ;

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners for Montgomery county to levy a sum of money to compensate certain bridge commissioners therein mentioned ;

The bill entitled, an act to allow William J. Johnson, of Montgomery county to erect gates on public road in said county ;

The bill entitled, an act to divorce Charles Frederick Berger, from his wife Margaret Berger ;

The bill entitled, an act in aid of the construction of an out let lock of the Tide Water canal at Bell's ferry in Harford county, immediately opposite Port Deposit in Cecil county ;

The bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed Dec. session 1838, ch. 362, entitled ;

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the village commonly called and known by the name of Nine bridges, and to change thereof to Bridgetown in Caroline county ;

And the bill entitled, an act to regulate the measurement of oats ;

Severally endorsed "will pass" and ordered to be engrossed.

And returned the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate pilots and to establish their fees, passed November session 1803, ch. 63 ;

Endorsed "amendments of the House of Delegates proposed to amendments of the Senate, "assented to." Ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise Kitty Turner, of the District of Columbia, to bring into this State certain negroes, slaves for life ;

Endorsed "will pass" with the proposed amendment.

Amendment proposed.

Read the first and by special order the second time, assented to, and ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered a bill entitled, an act to authorise the drawing of a lottery for the establishment of a female seminary in Prince George's county—Endorsed will pass ;

Read and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Maccubbin and Sprigg.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Jennings's Valley Rail Road and Turnpike company—Endorsed "will pass ;"

Read and referred to the committee on corporations.
