At the end of the 3d section add, "save only that in all such cases the clerk of said court shall tax only half the legal charges established by law in cases of indictment found by a grand jury, and that all cases if presented for violation of the act to regulate the issuing of licenses to taverns and keepers of ordinaries, passed December session 1827, ch. 117, and the several supplements thereto at the election of the party presented, may be tried upon said presentment and be chargeable only with half the legal cost aforesaid ;
