So the house refused to refer it to the next General Assembly of Maryland.

The Speaker called Mr. Mason to the chair.

On motion of Mr. Spence,

The further consideration of said bill was postponed until to-morrow.

The house took up for consideration the bill entitled, an act to authorise the justices of the levy court of Frederick county, and the commissioners of Carroll county to erect a bridge over the Monocacy River, at or near the grist mill of Daniel Sell, on the public road leading from Emmittsburg to Littlestown, Pennsylvania.

On motion of Mr. Wilmer,

The said bill, together with the substitute therefor, was referred to the consideration of the next General Assembly.

The house took up for consideration the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Havre de Grace, in Harford county.

On motion of Mr. Spence,

The 1st section of said bill was amended by striking out the word "perpetual" in the 4th line thereof.

On motion of Mr. Spence,

All after the word "currency" in the third line of the 20th section, to the end of said section, was stricken out, and the following added as an additional section:

And be it enacted, That this act shall continue and be in force for the period of 30 years from the passage thereof, unless sooner repealed, altered or amended by the Legislature of this State.
