On motion of Mr. Owens,

Said report was laid on the table.

The rule being suspended,

Mr. Berry, from the select committee to whom was referred the bill from the senate entitled, an act relating to stocks held by non-residents, and to provide an easy mode of transferring the same, reported favorably thereon ;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

The next in order is the unfavorable report of the committee on agriculture, on the memorial of the butchers of Baltimore and certain drovers, relating to weighing of live cattle ;

Read the second time.

Mr. Le Grand moved as a substitute for the same the following—

An act to repeal an act to provide for the weighing of live stock in the city of Baltimore, passed December session 1837 ;

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act of December session 1837, providing for the weighing of live stock in the city of Baltimore, be and the same is hereby repealed ;

Which was read.

On the question being put, Will the house adopt the said substitute?

Mr. Selby moved the previons question, and being demanded by a majority of the members prrsent, the main question was then put—

Will the house adopt the said substitute ?
