The next in order is the bill entitled, an act relative to public roads in Frederick county;

Read the second time and will not pass.

The next in order is the bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Arthur, of Carroll county, from her husband Joseph Arthur;

Read the second time and will pass.

The next in order is the bill entitled, an act authorizing the levy court of Frederick county, in their discretion to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Fishing Creek, at or near Lewistown, on the road leading from Mechanics' town to Frederick;

Read the second time and will pass.

The next in order is the bill entitled, an act to authoize John Lammott, former collector of district, of Baltimore county, now part in Carroll, to complete his collections;

On motion of Mr. Stansbury,

The second section was stricken out and the following inserted: "And be it enacted that the said John Lammott shall not be entitled to collect any bill of taxes from any person who will make oath before some justice of the peace according to the best of his or her knowledge that said taxes have been already paid;"

Read the second time as amended and will pass.
