Read the first and by special order the second time, assented to and sent to the senate.

Mr. England asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act relating to the education of the indigent children in in Montgomery county;

Referred to Messrs. England, Waters and Dade.

Mr. Hook submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the bill, entitled, an act further to provide for the payment of the interest on the public debt of this State, and for the conversion of its sterling bonds into currency debt, which was made the order of the day for the 16th instant, be taken up at 12 o'clock to-day.

On the question being put—

Will the house adopt said order?

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Byer reported a bill, entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and returned to the senate.

Mr. Biser reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the Frederick and Baltimore turnpike road, commencing at the west end of Fredericktown to Harper's Ferry on the Potomac river;

Read the first and by special order the second time.

Mr. Giles moved to amend said bill by adding as an additional section the following—

And be it further enacted, That the rights and privileges hereby granted shall cease and determine at the end of the year eighteen hundred and forty-five;

Which was read.

On the question being put: will the house adopt the said amendment?

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred on the passage of said bill, and on being put—

It was determined in the affirmative,

And sent to the senate.

Mr. Hope, from the select committee to whom was referred the bill from the senate entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to authorise and empower persons owning real estate on any of the navigable waters of this State, to construct wharves thereon, passed December session 1835, chapter 168;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and returned to the senate.
