

And the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act for the relief of Samuel G. Holbrook, of Somerset county;

At the end of the bill add—

Provided, that the said Holbrook shall not proceed to collect or receive any balance or amount aforesaid, until he shall have made affidavit before some justice of the peace of said county, or when the estate of a deceased person is affected before the register of wills, for said county, that said balance or amount so justly due, and that he hath not received any payment, security or satisfaction for the same or any part thereof, nor any person for him save the credits, if any given, on the written statement or account of said balance or amount, nor until a certificate of such affidavit by the officer taking the same shall have been endorsed on said written statement or account, annexed thereto.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, assented to and ordered to be engrossed.
