And that at the next election for delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, after the passage of this act, the citizens of this State in the several counties and the city of Baltimore, qualified to vote for delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, shall vote for a person of experience, sound legal knowledge and good moral character, to be styled the State's attorney for the particular county in which he may be elected, and the person receiving the greatest number of legal votes according to the return of the judges of elections in the several counties of this State and the city of Baltimore, shall be considered duly elected the State's attorney for the particular county or city in which he may have so received the greatest number of legal votes; and the person so elected shall reside in the county or city in which he may have been elected, and shall hold his office for the period of three years, and shall be ineligible to the same office for the space of three years after the expiration of his term. of The rule being suspended,
