Mr. Hearn moved to amend said substitute by adding as an additional section the following

And be it enacted, That the commissioner of loans be and he is hereby required to issue State bonds or certificates of stock to the amount of five hundred thousand dollars, bearing an interest of six per cent. per annum, payable quarterly at the loan office in the city of Baltimore, which bonds or certificates of stock shall be redeemable at the pleasure of the State after the year 1890, and pay over the same to five commissioners to be appointed by the Governor, which commissioners shall apply the same only to the construction of a canal of sufficient depth and dimensions for the use and navigation of such vessels as now navigate the Pocomoke river, between the Pocomoke and the Annamessex rivers.

On the question being put, will the house adopt the amendment?
