

The bill, entitled a supplement to the act passed December session, 1813, ch. 102, entitled an act relating to sheriffs, and for other purposes.

And the bill, entitled, an act to abolish in the State of Maryland the law of imprisonment for debt.

Severally endorsed "will not pass."

And delivered a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province, and limiting the extent of them;

Endorsed "will pass."

Read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

The house then took up for consideration the bill entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland.

On motion of Mr. Hammond,

"And all the revenue, property and estate which may at any time hereafter belong to said company," were inserted after the word "company" in the 10th line of the 1st section.

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

"To the State of Maryland" were inserted after the word "securing" in the same line.

Mr. Hammond moved further to amend said bill by striking out "one" in the 15th line of the 1st section and inserting "five";

On the question being put,

It was determined in the negative.

Mr. Bowie moved to amend said section by striking out all after the word "year," in the 18th line, to the end thereof and inserting the following:

"And the said commissioner of loans, is hereby directed to sell and dispose of said certificates of stock or bonds of this State, whenever he can do so, at a price or sum which shall net not less than par, and the said commissioner of loans is further directed to pay the proceeds of such sales as soon as he can do so, into the Treasury of the Western Shore; provided that nothing in this act contained shall be construed as authorizing the said commissioner of loans, to sell or contract to sell the said stock or bonds in whole or in part, to said Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, or to any other internal improvement company in this State;
