Petition of sundry citizens of, for a lottery to finish an Academy, and for other purposes in Denton in, presented and referred 324; order in relation thereto, rejected 345; unfavorable report thereon 515.

Petition of 96 citizens of, for the repeal of the School law of said county, passed in 1838, presented and referred 329.

Leave to bring in a bill to raise a lottery in the town of Denton in, to be applied to the benefit of an Academy in said town, granted and referred 330; taken up, passed and sent to the senate 519; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 541.

Leave to bring in a bill to relieve the sheriff of, from the collection of officers' fees and for other purposes, granted and referred 330; reported, passed and sent to the senate 469; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 541.

Communication from the Clerk of, relating to his claim against the State, presented and referred 343.

Petition of 62 citizens of the Upper district of, for an additional School district therein mentioned, presented and referred 417.

Memorial of sundry citizens of, for the repeal of certain laws therein mentioned, presented and referred 417.

Petition from sundry persons of, to change location of a District school in, presented and referred 428.

Leave to bring in a bill to alter and change the location of several sites or locations of sites for District schools in, and also to lay off such other districts as may be necessary, granted and referred 428.

Bill entitled an act to incorporate a company for the purpose of clearing, widening and otherwise opening the Long Marsh Ditch between Queen Anne's and, from Kerr's Cross Roads, to a certain tract of land called and known by the name of Stratten, reported and passed 437; sent to the senate 441; returned with amendments which are assented to and ordered to be engrossed 510.

Bill reported entitled an act for the distribution of the interest on the State's share of the surplus revenue so far as relates to, laid on the table 536; taken up, passed and sent to the senate 548; returned with amendments, which are assented to and ordered to be engrossed 618.
