Leave to bring in a bill for the relief certain persons of color therein named, granted and referred 78; reported 79; and referred to the committee on *ib.* substitute therefor reported and adopted, passed and sent to the senate 193; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 241.

Order directing the committee on the, to report a detailed statement from the officers of the colonization society of the State, shewing the number of persons and their places of residence, anterior to transportation, the number and grade of officers of, &c. 177.

Bill from the committee on the, for the relief of certain persons of color therein named, reported and laid on the table 290; taken up 484; passed and sent to the senate 485; returned endorsed will not pass 542.

Order instructing the committee on, to report favorably on no application to bring into this State, any negroes other than slaves for life, submitted 299; and laid on the table 300.
