Petition of sundry citizens of, for the passage of an act to redress grievances for injuries done by fire, emanating from Steam Engines on the Baltimore and Ohio rail road, presented and referred 534.

Petition of the Junior Fire Company of Frederick, that the levy court of, may be authorised to levy a certain sum of money for the use of said company, presented and referred 559.

Leave to bring in a bill to make valid manumission of negroes Charles and George, under the last will and testament of Elizabeth Sower, late of, deceased, granted and referred 559; reported and referred to the committee on colored population 585; reported favorably upon and referred to the next General Assembly 655.

Bill entitled a further supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike road from the Frederick and Baltimore Turnpike road, commencing at the west end of Fredericktown to Harper's Ferry on the Potomac river, reported, amended, passed and sent to the senate 560; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 574.

FREE NEGROES—Leave to bring in a bill relating to the children of, granted and referred 23; reported, passed and sent to the senate 56; returned endorsed will not pass 451; message asking the senate to reconsider, proposed and adopted 460.

Leave to bring in a bill to repeal part of an act relating to, passed December session 1831, ch. 323; granted and referred 146; reported, passed and sent to the senate 601.

Leave to bring in a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to, and slaves 167; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 332; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 435.

Bill from the senate entitled, an additional supplement to the act of 1831, ch. 323, entitled, an act relating to, and slaves, received and referred 215; reported favorably upon and laid on the table 484; taken up and amended 587; further amended and postponed 588; resumed 590; various proceedings thereon, passed and returned to the senate 591.
