

INTERNAL IMPROVEMENTS—

Order directing the committee on, to require the President of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to report to this house forthwith, whether he deems it important to the interest of the State, that an appropriation should be made to said canal, during the present session of the legislature, submitted 239; adopted 240.

Order directing the committee on, to inquire into the expediency of providing by law that the several internal improvement companies, in which the State may be interested, shall make their annual report, on or before the 15th day of December, in each year 241.
