Cecil county for the legislature to extend the jurisdiction of single, for the said county to one hundred dollars, presented and referred 265.

Memorial of sixty-eight citizens of Cecil county, for the legislature to pass a law extending the jurisdiction of, to one hundred dollars, presented and referred 692.

Bill from the committee on grievances and courts of justice reported unfavorably upon, entitled, an act to extend the jurisdiction of, for Cecil county and for other purposes, and laid on the table 376; taken up and substitute proposed therefor, which is adopted and bill passed and sent to the senate 477; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 477.

Leave to bring in a bill to regulate the action of, in Montgomery county, granted and referred 496; reported and laid on the table 520; taken up 572; passed and sent to the senate 572; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 605.

Petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, for the repeal of the District Court law, and the extension of the jurisdiction of single, to one hundred dollars, presented and referred 187.

Petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, for the repeal of the act to establish magistrates courts and its supplements and for the extension of single, so far as the same relates to said county, presented and referred 197.

Memorial of sundry citizens of Frederick county, for a repeal of the several acts and supplements creating magistrates courts in said county and extending the jurisdiction of single, to one hundred dollars, presented and referred 286.

Memorial of fifty-one citizens of Frederick county, for the repeal of a law entitled, an act to establish magistrates' courts in the several counties of this State, and that concurrent jurisdiction be given to, with the county courts in all cases of single debt, presented and referred, 329; unfavorable report and laid on the table 620.
