Petition of sundry citizens of Harford county, landholders, that so much of the act, No. 327, of December session 1835, as relates to the enquiry and assessment of damages done to private property by the Baltimore and Port Deposit, be repealed, and that a law may be passed extending to land holders the same privileges that were granted to land holders along the line of the Tide Water Canal, presented and referred 344.

Order instructing the committee on internal improvements to inquire whether or not the fifth section of the act of assembly of 1833, chapter 395, has been complied with on the part of the Baltimore and Ohio, Company, and if not whether the said company has incurred the forfeiture mentioned in said section, proposed and various proceedings thereon 344; laid on the table 345.

Order directing the committee on internal improvements forthwith to lay before the house the letter of Messrs. Barings, Brothers, & Co., received from the president of the Baltimore and Ohio, Company, proposed and adopted 358; laid before the house 383 and 384.

Bill from the committee on internal improvements, to complete the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and the Baltimore and Susquehanna, to the borough of York, reported and made the order of the day 473; taken up and made the order of the day 569; withdrawn 596.

Petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, for the passage of an act to redress grievances for injuries done by fire, emanating from steam engines on the Baltimore and Ohio, presented and referred 534.

Petition of M. Duval, for remuneration for services
