Leave to bring in a bill to incorporate a company to make a turnpike, from Hagerstown, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania line, passed April session 1838, ch. 321, granted and referred 375; reported and passed 377; sent to the senate 391; returned with amendments 433; which are assented to and bill ordered to be engrossed 438.

Leave to bring in a bill to authorise a lottery to construct a turnpike, from Hagerstown, in Washington county, through Leitersburgh to the Pennsylvania line, and for introducing wholesome water into the town of Leitersburgh, granted and referred 393; unfavorable report and laid on the table 412; taken up and substitute proposed, adopted and bill sent to the senate 463; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 497.

Bill entitled an act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to appoint commissioners to alter a, called the old, leading from Middletown to Hagerstown, reported, passed and sent to the senate 601; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 628.

Petition of John Parsons and others, of Somerset county, that a law may be passed for the establishment of a, therein mentioned, presented and referred 143.

Leave to bring in a bill to provide by lottery for turnpiking a, from Rockville, in Montgomery county, to the Monocacy bridge, granted and referred 581; reported and laid on the table 584; taken up 591; various proceedings thereon, passed and sent to the senate 592; returned endorsed, will pass and ordered to be engrossed 625.
