

SLAVES—Petition of A. F. Dulin of the city of Baltimore to bring two, into this State, presented and referred 247; unfavorable report and laid on the table 519.

Leave to bring in a bill to authorise Doctor A. M. Panan, of the city of Baltimore to bring into this State from the State of Virginia four negro, for life, granted and referred 33; reported and amended 156; passed and sent to the senate 157; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 226.

Petition of William Brewer of the city of Annapolis for a law to be passed, authorising him to manumit a certain negro, therein named, presented and referred 57; bill taken up and laid on the table 535; referred to the next general assembly 655.

Order instructing the committee on colored population to report favorably on no application to bring into this State any negroes other than, for life, submitted 299; and laid on the table 300.

Petition of George R. Kelso, for the passage of a law to authorise him to bring into this State two negro girls, for life, presented and referred 386; bill reported and laid on the table 418; taken up, passed and sent to the senate 504; returned endorsed will not pass 574; message to the senate in relation to 575; bill returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 593.

Petition of Samuel Hurlock of Kent county, for the passage of an act to authorise him to remove a certain, for life, therein mentioned, into this State, presented and referred 166; unfavorable report and laid on the table 519.

Leave to bring in a bill to authorise Samuel Leonard to remove into this State four, for life, granted and referred 74; reported, passed and sent to the senate 80; returned will pass with amendments, they assented to and bill ordered to be engrossed 135.

Leave to bring in a bill to permit Doctor Andrew A. Lynch, to bring into this State, a, for life, granted and referred 239; unfavorable report and laid on the table 519; taken up and concurred in 576.

Leave to report a bill to authorise Doctor John A. E. Horsey, to introduce into this State certain, for life, granted and referred 18; reported, passed and sent to the senate 33; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 93.

Bill from the senate entitled, an act to authorise Henry S. Dent of Charles county, to bring into this State certain negroes, for life, received and referred 336; bill reported and referred to the committee on colored population 359; unfavorable report, and laid on the table 519; bill taken up and will not pass 576.
