Leave to bring in a bill to authorise Philip R. E. Contee to introduce into this State certain negro, for life, granted and referred 132; bill reported and amendments proposed 151; assented to and bill passed and sent to the senate 152; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 177.

Leave to bring in a bill to authorise Eleanor R. Contee to introduce into this State, certain negro, for life, granted and referred 132; bill reported 135; amendments proposed assented to, passed and sent to the senate 152; returned endorsed will pass and ordered to be engrossed 176.

Petition of Thomas Martin, of Prince George's county, that he may be allowed to bring into this State two negro, without incurring the usual tax, presented and referred 266; unfavorable report 348, taken up and concurred in 550.

Leave to bring in a bill entitled, an act to permit William Bryan of Richard of Prince George's county to bring into this State a negro, for life, granted and referred 418.

Petition of John T. Singleton and others of Hampshire county, Virginia, who intend shortly to remove to Allegany county, Maryland, praying the passage of an act to authorise him to bring into this State certain negro, with the privilege to work said, in this State and Virginia at his pleasure, presented and referred 458; bill reported and laid on the table 559; taken up and referred to the next general assembly 654.
