Resolution directing the treasurer of the, to pay to Andrew Slicer, messenger of the Senate, and William Murdoch, door-keeper of the House of Delegates, sixty dollars each, for taking care of their respective rooms and furniture during the recess of the legislature, proposed, assented to and sent to the senate 619; returned endorsed, assented to and ordered to be engrossed 627.

Resolution directing the treasurer of the, to pay the accounts of Andrew Slicer, William Woodcock, T. Palmer & Co., Richard Thompson, and Joseph Robinson, for work done and materials furnished for the use of the Senate and its officers in the Senate Chamber, provided the whole amount of payments of said accounts shall not exceed the sum of ninety-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, proposed, assented to and sent to the senate 639.

Resolution directing the treasurer of the, to pay to Daniel Caulk, or to his order the sum of eight dollars for two days services as Sergeant at Arms during the indisposition of the present Sergeant, assented to and sent to the senate 649.

Resolution directing the treasurer of the, to pay to Wm. McNeir, eighteen dollars for printing done by him since the journal of accounts was closed, proposed, assented to and sent to the senate 649.

Resolution directing the treasurer of the, to pay the postage on journals, documents and letters to which members are entitled, that may be sent to them from the seat of government, within sixty days after the adjournment of the legislature, proposed, assented to and ordered to be engrossed 649.
