

The Speaker also laid before the house reports from the clerks of Frederick and Queen Anne's counties, relative to the attendance of the judges;

Which were read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice, hereafter to be appointed.

On motion of Mr. Causin,

Ordered, That all that portion of the Governor's message, which relates to the distribution of the proceeds of the public lands, be referred to a select committee.

In pursuance whereof, the Speaker appointed Messrs. Causin, E. A. Lynch, Gaither, Jones of Somerset, Tuck, Prestman and Martin to compose said committee.

Mr. Jones of Somerset, submitted the following order:

Ordered, That Jeremiah Hughes be employed to execute the printing of this house, under the direction of the chief clerk, until the joint committee upon printing of the two houses shall have made their report: provided, he will agree to execute the said printing at a price not exceeding that paid for the printing of the journal of the last house.

Which was read.

Mr. Seidenstricker moved to amend said order, by striking out the proviso in said order, and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "Provided, he will agree to do it as low as any other printer in the city, and in an equally workmanlike manner;"

Determined in the negative.
