The house then resumed the consideration of the unfinished order of yesterday, being the bill reported by Mr. Gantt, entitled an act to authorise the Banks of the State of Maryland, to receive and pay out the orders drawn by the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, on the stock of the city of Baltimore:

The question before the house being upon the amendments offered by Mr. Nesbitt, as the 3d & 4th sections of the bill;

Mr. Nesbitt, by permission of the house, withdrew his amendments;

The said bill having been read through as amended;

Mr. Holmes moved further to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following :

“And be it enacted, That all such banks as shall receive and pay out the stock orders as hereinbefore provided, shall redeem the same in specie, when they resume the payment of specie for their debts and obligations;”
