

Ordered, That Messrs. Martin, Lowe and Willis report the same.

Mr. Gantt, from the committee on lotteries, made an unfavorable report upon the bill reported by Mr. E. A. Lynch, entitled an act to revive an act passed at December session 1834, ch. 205, entitled a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to authorise a lottery for certain purposes therein mentioned;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, and concurred in.

Mr. Gantt, from the committee on lotteries, reported a bill, entitled an act for the benefit of the commissioners appointed under and by virtue of the act passed on the 19th March, 1835, ch. 222;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Presstman reported a bill, entitled an act supplementary to an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Farmers and Planters Bank of Baltimore, passed at December session 1835, ch. 315, and to repeal the 1st and 2d sections of an act passed at December session 1838, ch. 218; and

Mr. Simcoe reported a bill, entitled an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned;

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Martin, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, made an unfavorable report upon the petition of Charles Johnson, of Dorchester county, praying the passage of an act to authorise the orphan's court of said county to appoint a trustee to manage the affairs of Maria Dean, a lunatic;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, and concurred in.

Mr. Gantt, from the committee on lotteries, made an unfavorable report upon the bill reported by Mr. Cathell, entitled an act for the clearing out of Pocomoke river, in Worcester county;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, and concurred in.

Mr. Gantt, from the committee on lotteries, to which was referred the bill, entitled an act to alter and regulate the mode of appointing lottery commissioners in this State, reported the same with the following amendments:

Amendments proposed,

1st section—Strike out "one thousand" and insert "twelve hundred and fifty;"

2nd section—Strike out the whole section.

4th section—Strike out the word "and" between the words "third" and "fourth;"

After the word "fourth" insert the words "and nineteenth;"

In the third line strike out all between the word "of" and the word "as" and insert "all acts and parts of acts;"
