

Which was read; and

On motion of Mr. Sprigg of Allegany,

Referred to the committee on claims.

Mr. Estep reported a bill, entitled a further supplement to an act passed at December session 1828, ch. 21, entitled an act to abolish the levy court of Anne Arundel county, and for other purposes; and

Mr. Dorsey reported a bill, entitled an act to change the mode of electing the commissioners of the tax for Howard District, in Anne Arundel county;

Which were severally read the first, and by a special order the second time, and severally passed.

On motion of Mr. Graves,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Le Grand, from the committee on corporations, entitled an act to incorporate the German Herman Beneficial Society of Baltimore;

The said bill was then read the second time, and passed.

Mr. England, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, made a favorable report upon the bill, entitled an act to authorise Ephraim Rockhold, of Perry county, Ohio, to execute a deed to Abraham Seacrest, of Baltimore county, Maryland;

Which was read.

The said bill was then read the second time by a special order and passed.

Mr. Lecompte reported a bill, entitled an act to lay out, open and make a public road in Frederick and Carroll counties;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The hour having arrived for taking up the order of the day, the house proceeded to consider the unfavorable report of the committee on lotteries upon the petition of sundry citizens of Carroll county, praying for a lottery for the benefit of the town of Westminster, and the substitutes offered therefor by Mr. Orrick, from the minority of said committee, being the bill, entitled an act in aid of the construction of a building to be used as a public town hall, an academy of learning and library rooms, market house, engine house and armory and for the purchase of a fire engine in the town of Westminster, in Carroll county.

On motion of Mr. Causin,

Said report and substitute were postponed until the 10th of February.

Mr. Gaither submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the committee on claims be instructed to allow no additional pay to the members of the committees who have been or may hereafter be appointed to leave the city of Annapolis for any purpose whatsoever;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.
