proceedings, documents, books and papers of the said Commissioner of Loans, and if they find the amount of bonds, certificates or other evidences of the State's indebtedness, in his possession, which have been satisfied, and are of no use, and ought to be destroyed, to correspond with the report, herein before directed to be made to the Legislature, by the said Commissioner of Loans, then, and in that case, the said committee shall proceed to burn them in the manner herein before directed, and make report thereof to the Legislature; but if the amount of bonds, certificates, or other evidences of indebtedness of this State, found in possession of the said Commissioner of Loans, shall vary from the statement contained in the said Commissioner's report to the Legislature, it shall be the duty of the said committee to report the fact to the Legislature, in order that such proceedings may be had thereon, as to the General Assembly may seem expedient.

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Graves,

Ordered, That it be entered upon the journal, that Mr. Seidenstricker's absence from the house is owing to severe sickness in his family.
