So the bill was rejected.

Mr. Jones of Somerset, moved to refer said bill to the committee

on grievances and courts of justice;

Resolved in the affimative. On motion of Mr. Nesbitt,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by, him, entitled an act to reduce and establish a uniform system of charges by notaries public on all protested notes, drafts and bills of exchange, and the amendment reported thereto from the committee.

The amendment having been read,

Mr. Le Grand moven to amend said amendment, by striking out out all after the word "dollar," to the end thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof, "seventy-five cents;"

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred and was put upon the amendment as reported by the committee, and

Resolved in the affirmative.

The said bill having been read through as amended,

Mr. Le Grand moved to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following:

"And be it enacted, That nothing herein contained shall relate to the city of Baltimore;"

Which was read,

Mr. Martin moved to amend said amendments by adding at the end thereot, the words, "or Talbot county;"

Resolved in the affirmative. On motion of Mr. Gantt,

Said amendment was amended by inserting "City of Annapolis and Howard District in Anne Arundel county;"

On motion of Mr. Lecompte,

Said amendment was further amended by inserting "Carroll county;"

On motion of Mr. Sprigg of Allegany,

Said amendment was further amended by inserting "Allegany county;"

On motion of Mr. Poultney,

"Baltimore county," was inserted in said amendment,

On motion of Mr. Sutton,

"Harford county," was also inserted, in said amendment;
