Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby directed to pay Amos Singleton, of Harford county, who lost his right thumb whilst in the service of the State discharging his duty in assisting to suppress a riot, annually in quarterly payments, during his life, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a private;

Which was read the first and by special order the second time,

and

On motion of Mr. Maccubbin,

Referred to the committee on pensions and revolutionary claims. The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act to repeal the several acts passed at December session 1839, chapters 79, 92 and 94, and allowing to the sheriffs of Queen Anne's, Caroline and Talbot counties, eight per cent. commission for the collection of fees; also

The bill entitled an act to incorporate the Washington Temperance Society of Baltimore;

Severally endorsed "will pass" and the bills severally ordered to

be engrossed; and

Delivered a bill, originated in and passed by the senate, entitled an act to incorporate the Eastern Hotel Company of Cumberland, in the town of Cumberland:

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations. Also, a communication from the Secretary of the Baltimore and York Turnpike Road Company," enclosing an abstract of the accounts of said company;

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal im-

provement.

Mr. Gaither reported a bill entitled an act supplementary to an act, entitled an act for the prevention of frauds on the right of voting by the stockholders in the several incorporated institutions in this State, passed at December session 1836, chapter 264;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second

time;

On motion of Mr. Coade,

Said bill was laid on the table and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Gaither reported a bill, entitled a supplement to an act to incorporate the town of Havre De Grace, in Harford county, passed at December session 1839, chapter 267; and

Mr. William Lynch reported a bill, entitled an act to incorporate a library association in the town of Jefferson, in Frederick county;
