

Ordered, That Messrs. Tuck, Bowie and Maccubbin report the same.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Ordered. That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the house, the memorial of the Western Beneficial Society, praying for an act of incorporation.

Mr. Nesbitt asked and obtained the following leave:

Leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled an act to increase the price of licenses granted to hawkers and pedlars within this State;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Ordered, That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the house the petition of David Richter, of the city of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Maccubbin,

Ordered, That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the house, the petition and papers of Zadoch Robinson and others, of Prince George's county, and that they be referred to a select committee of three.

In pursuance whereof the Speaker appointed Messrs. Maccubbin, Tuck and Bowie the committee.

Mr. Graves obtained leave to bring in a bill to reform the present constitution of Maryland;

Ordered, That Messrs. Graves, Tuck, E. A. Lynch, Jones of Somerset, and Foreman, be a committee to prepare and report the same

Mr. Tuck obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act to extend the act to extend the time of Thomas Baldwin, late sheriff of Prince George's county, for collecting his fees;

Ordered, That Messrs. Tuck, Bowie and Maccubbin report the same.

Mr. Sprigg of Allegany, submitted the following resolution;

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col. C. M. Thurston, the sum of four hundred and forty-seven dollars and twenty-one cents, being the amount due for supplies furnished the troops under his command when on an expedition against the rioters on the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal; which sum he is to pay over to the respective claimants;

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hope submitted the following resolution:

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby authorised to pay to the several members of this General Assembly, and the several officers thereof, or to their respective orders, the several sums of money now due, or that from time to time may become due to them respectively; also to the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, and the officers thereof, the amount of the
