

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That no decree heretofore passed by the chancellor or any county court as a court of equity, in which an infant or infants may have been interested, shall be reversed or set aside or in any way interfered with upon the ground that no commission had issued to take testimony, or that no replication had been filed except in those cases where fraud in obtaining the decree shall be alleged and proved;

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That the county courts as courts of equity, shall have jurisdiction in all cases in equity, where the proceedings shall be commenced in the court of the county where the land mentioned in the proceedings and to be affected by them, may lie in whole or in part; or in the court of the country, where the defendants or any of them may reside, at the time of filing the bill or petition; provided, that if a proceeding be commenced in a county where all the land does not lie, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to transmit to the clerk of the county where the land, or any part thereof, may lie, a copy of the proceedings, to be recorded among the land records of said county;

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That the fees of the auditors of the county courts as courts of equity, shall be the same as those of the auditor in chancery;

Which were read.

The bill reported by Mr. Nail, from the committee on divorces, entitled an act to divorce Mary Dorsey, of Frederick county, from her husband Benjamin Dorsey,

Was taken up for consideration and read the second time.

Mr. E. A. Lynch moved to amend said bill by striking out the words "a vinculo matrimonii," and inserting in lieu thereof "a mensa et thoro,"
