Ordered, That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the house the memorials of sundry citizens of Somerset and Worcester counties, presented at December session 1837, praying for a new county on the Eastern Shore.

Mr. Le Grand obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act authorising the correction of an error in a patent therein mentioned;

Ordered, That Messrs. Le Grand, Poultney and Randall report the same.

Mr. Seidenstricker obtained leave to bring in a bill to authorise the corporation of Baltimore city to license wood hucksters in said city;

Ordered, That Messrs. Seidenstricker, Dalrymple, Frazier, Lowe and Rider report the same.

Mr. Gallagher obtained leave to bring in a bill to incorporate the Howard Temperance Society of Fell's Point;

Ordered, That Messrs. Gallagher, Le Grand and Pressman report the same.

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

Ordered, That the committee on ways and means have leave to sit during the session of the house.

Mr. Shower obtained leave to bring in a bill, to be entitled an act to authorise Thomas Hook, former collector of Carroll county, to complete his collections;

Ordered, That Messrs. Shower, Stull and Boyle report the same.
