And the bill sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Brent, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, entitled an act to make valid a deed of trust from William Lamar to Michael C. Sprigg, of Allegany county,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill from the Senate, entitled an act to allow the executors of A. Beall, late clerk of Prince George's county court to collect the fees which were due to the said A. Beall,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Martin, entitled an act relating to sheriffs in this State, was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Graves,

Said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act empowering the commissioners of Baltimore county to build a bridge across Gwynn's falls, at or near the Franklin factory;

Also the bill, entitled an act for the relief of the bailiffs of Frederick county court;

Also the bill, entitled an act to confirm the proceedings of the commissioners of primary schools of Howard District, in Anne Arundel county, in altering the school districts in said Howard District;
