

Also the bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of the Diocese of Maryland, for the purposes therein mentioned; and

The bill, entitled a supplement to an act for the relief of sundry poor persons in the several counties therein mentioned, passed at December session 1839, ch. 309;

Severally endorsed "will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed;

And delivered the following message:

*By the Senate,*

February 13th, 1841.

*Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:*

The senate appoints Mr. Beall on its part, to carry into effect, conjointly with the gentlemen appointed by your honorable body, the resolutions of the General Assembly, relative to certain six per cent. bonds of the State and to the Commissioner of Loans.

Which was read;

Mr. Bowie, chairman of the committee on ways and means, reported a bill, entitled an act to raise revenue for the support of Government;

Which was read the first time; and

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

Ordered to be printed.

Mr. Hooper moved that the house adjourn;

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Nesbitt reported a bill, entitled an act concerning the Franklin Rail Road;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Presstman,

The house took up for consideration the bill reported by Mr. Leconte, from the committee on corporations, entitled an act to incorporate the Rose Hill Improving Company of Baltimore;

Mr. Graves moved to amend said bill, by adding at the end of the 4th section thereof the following:

"And that the stockholders in said company shall be held in their individual responsibility for all debts incurred in prosecuting the objects as specified in this act;"

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read the second time,

On motion of Mr. Graves,

Said bill was laid on the table;

Mr. Hooper moved that the house adjourn,

Determined in the negative.

The bill reported by Mr. Leconte from the committee on corporations, entitled an act to incorporate the Atlantic Mutual Insurance Company of Baltimore,
