

Mr. Lecompte presented the petition of sundry citizens of Carroll county and Howard District, praying for a road therein mentioned; Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. Gallagher obtained leave to report a bill to incorporate the Baltimore Hebrew and English Benevolent Academical Association;

Ordered, That Messrs. Gallagher, Presstman and Seidenstricker report the same.

Mr. William Lynch obtained leave to bring in a bill to incorporate the Methodist Episcopal Church in Fredericktown, in Frederick county;

Ordered, That Messrs. William Lynch, Motter, and Richardson report the same.

Mr. Hearn obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act to change the distribution of the academy fund in Worcester county;

Ordered, That Messrs. Hearn, Cathell and Forman report the same.

Mr. Holmes, from the committee on divorces, reported a bill, entitled an act to divorce Mary Ann Fowler, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband, Benjamin Fowler, a vinculo matrimonii; and

Mr. Morton, from the same committee, reported a bill, entitled an act to divorce Lydia Ann Greenwell, of the city of Annapolis, from her husband, Joseph W. Greenwell, a mensa et thoro;

Mr. Ford reported a bill, entitled an additional supplement to an act passed at December session 1833, ch. 110; and

Mr. Dorsey reported a bill, entitled an act to authorise the commissioners of the tax of Anne Arundel county to pay over to the commissioners of the tax of Howard District, whatever sum or sums of money may be due from Anne Arundel county to Howard District;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Gantt, from the committee on lotteries, made an unfavorable report upon the petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, praying for a grant of a lottery to enable them to build a church in the town of Jefferson, in said county;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time;

Mr. Nesbitt offered as a substitute for said report, a bill, entitled an act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money to build a German Evangelical Reformed Church in the town of Jefferson, in Frederick county;

Which was read;

On the question being put, will the house adopt said substitute? it was

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred, and was put upon concurring in the report of the committee; and

Resolved in the affirmative.
