Mr. Tuck reported a bill, entitled a further supplement to the act to incorporate the Upper Marlbro' Academy, passed at December session 1835, ch. 204;

Mr. Edes reported a bill, entled an act to incorporate the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Quaker Neck, in Kent county, and for other purposes;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, and passed.

Mr. Sprigg of Allegany, reported a bill, entitled an act to increase the sheriff's commission for the collection of attorneys' and officers' fees in Allegany county;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time.

On motion of Mr. Martin,

Said bill was amended, by inserting after the word "Allegany," the words "and Talbot;"

The said bill was then passed as amended.

On motion of Mr. Martin,

The title of said bill was amended, by striking out "county," and inserting "and Talbot counties."

Mr. Hooper reported a bill, entitled an act to change the place of holding elections in the fifth or Parsons' district, in Worcester county;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, and passed.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Atlantic Mutual Insurance Company of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;"

Which amendments were severally read the first, and by a special order the second time, severally assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed;

Also the bill, entitled a further supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate a Bank, to be called by the name of the Bank of Salisbury;

Also the bill, entitled an act to incorporate the Havre de Grace Real Estate and Manufacturing Company;
