Which amendments were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, severally assented to and the bills ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled an act to vest certain powers in the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, passed at December session, 1838, chapter 414;

Endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments;" which amendments were severally read the first time; and

Referred to the committee on ways and means.

Also, the resolution in favor of Leonard Shircliff and James Bryant;

Severally endorsed "assented to," and ordered to be engrossed;

And delivered the following bills originated in and passed by the Senate:

A bill, entitled an act relating to the removal of criminal cases from Baltimore city court;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Le Grand, Graves, Seidenstricker, Presstman and Gallagher.

And, a bill, entitled an act to incorporate the trustees of Bethel School House, in Cecil county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.

Also delivered a communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in obedience to resolution No. 77, of December session 1827;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

And the following message,
