So the house agreed to take up said bill.

Said section was further amended, by striking out, in the 7th and 8th lines, the words "and bearing interest;" and also by striking out, in the 12th line, the same words.

Said section was further amended, by inserting after the word "elsewhere," these words: "the interest or proportion in;" and by striking out in the 5th line, the words "in whole or in part."
