And, delivered the following resolution, originated in and passed by the senate:

Also, a resolution authorising the State Librarian to deliver certain books to the Steyvesant institute of New York;

Also, a resolution in favor of Richard I. Jones;

Which were severally read;

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

The house suspended the rule requiring said resolution to be referred to a committee, and the said resolutions were severally read the second time, severally assented to, and returned to the senate;

Also, a resolution in favor of Edward Dorsey, of Eli and Archibald Dorsey;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Also, a petition of sundry citizens of Kent county, praying legislative aid for the redress of the grievances therein complained of;

Which was read and referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

And, a petition of sundry persons on the subject of the license laws;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

And, delivered the following bills originated in and passed by the senate, viz:

A bill, entitled a supplement to the act, entitled an act to incorporate the mining and manufacturing company of Hibernia;

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.

A bill, entitled an act for the better regulation of primary schools, in Election District No. 2, in Allegany county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Sprigg, of Allegany, Coombs and Thayer.

A bill, entitled an act to prevent the collection of excessive wharfage in the city of Baltimore;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

A bill, entitled an act to authorise the commissioners of Cecil county, to issue writs of litation and attachment in certain cases;

Also, a bill entitled a further supplement to an act, entitled an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province, and of limiting the extent of them;
