

113 A supplement to an act, entitled an act to authorise Allegany County Court to ratify and confirm a sale made by Moses Rawlings, late sheriff of Allegany county, to William Knight and Jefferson M. Price of certain real estate, passed December session 1839, chapter 222.

114 An act to alter and change the place of holding the elections in the fourth election district of Dorchester county.

115 A supplement to an act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, chapter 396, entitled an act relating to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal.
