- 215 An act for the cleaning out of Pocomoke river, in Worcester county, by means of a lottery.
- 216 An act, supplemental to an act passed at December session 1813, ch. 102, entitled an act relating to sheriffs, and for other purposes.
- 217 An act to perfect and make valid the title of John B. Thom-Queen Anne's county, to certain negroes therein mentioned.
- 218 An act to incorporate the trustees of the Grove School House, in Cecil county.
- 219 An act for the opening of a new alley, and for the sale of a part of Cherry alley, in the town of Cumberland.
- 220 An act to divorce Nancy Myers, from her husband, Jacob Myers.
