

Also a report from John P. Wailes, inspector of tobacco in the city of Baltimore, relative to the several sums of money paid by him into the Western Shore Treasury, within the year ending on 30th November;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled an act authorising the justices of the levy court of Frederick county, and the commissioners of tax of Carroll county, to erect a bridge over the Monocacy river, near Daniel Sell's mill, on the public road leading from Emmitsburg to Littlestown, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;"

Which amendments were severally read the first and second time, by a special order, assented to and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered the following bills, originated in and passed by the Senate, viz.

A bill, entitled an act for the relief of Christiana Tabler, of Berkeley county, in the State of Virginia;

Which was read and referred to the committee on colored population.

And a bill, entitled a further supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate Fredericktown, in Frederick county, passed at December session 1816, ch. 74;

Which was read and referred to the committee on corporations.
